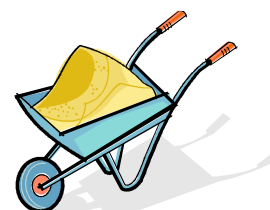
WORKING BEE

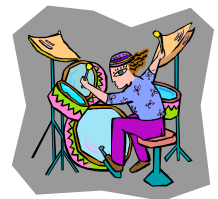
PREP BBQ 2012

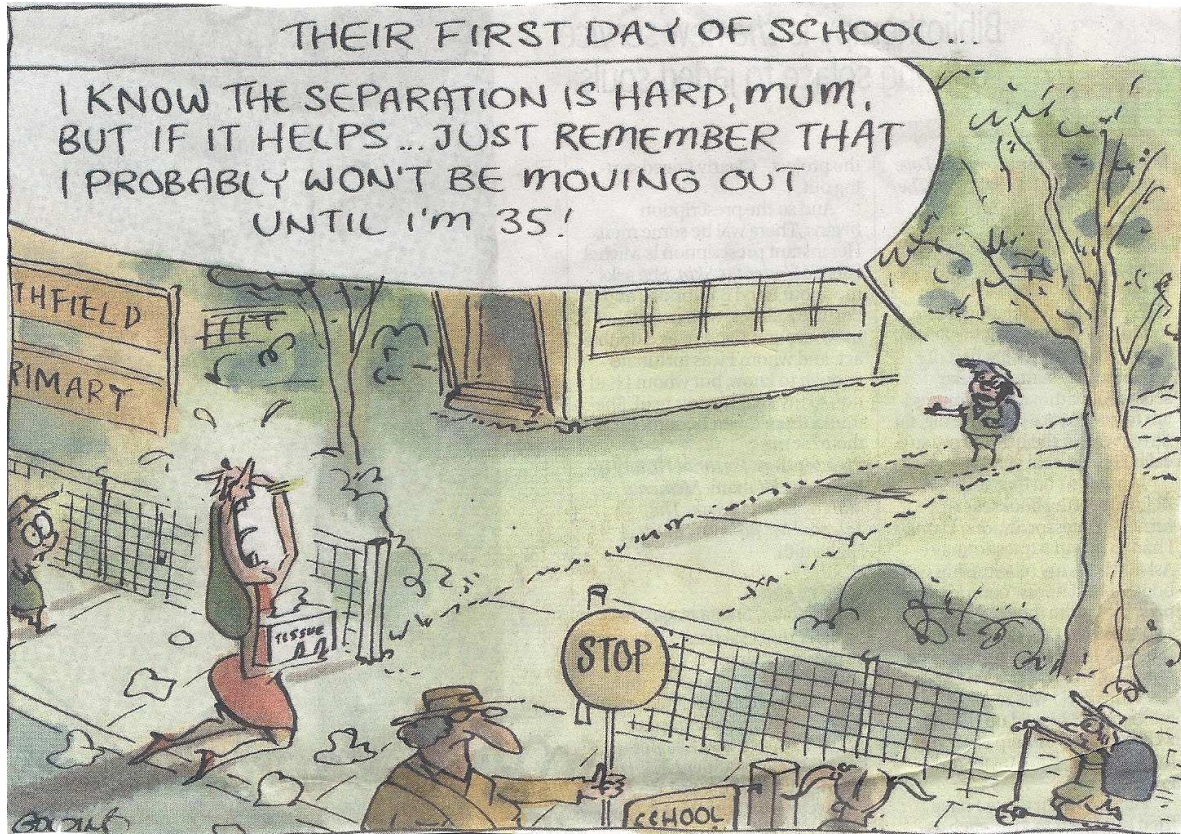

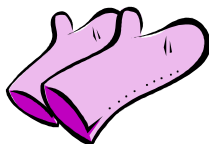

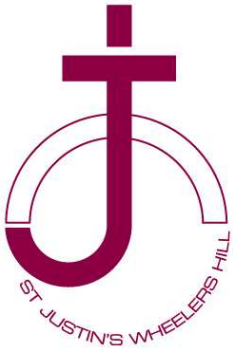
