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Music Academy


Sadly, due to the recent rise in COVID infections statewide and upon recommendation from the Catholic Education Office, we have had to postpone our return.

Monies raised by the Parents and Friends have been used to help fund these projects – thank you.



Prep Buddy Classes

On Tuesday, there was much excitement as the Preps found out that they were finally going to be able to visit their buddies again. They've missed them so much.

We made the exciting walk down to the Year 6 classrooms and the smiles on all of the students faces were so great to see. The Year 6 students had prepared a book for their buddies to read on their Chromebooks, as well as an art activity using their buddy's name. They then ate their lunch together.

Everyone was so happy to see each other and the smiles and positive energy were fantastic. No doubt they'll be asking to see each other again soon!

Medication – About to expire notifications

Any children who are required to have medication available during the school day have their medication and it's expiry date stored in a medication log. As the expiry dates come closer (4 – 6 weeks from expiry) we send a letter to the family to advise that medication is about to expire and that it requires replacement. We are not able to store expired medication onsite.

To assist us better in maintaining appropriate records, if your child no longer requires medication, please send an email to office@sjwheelershill.catholic.edu.au and let us know that the medication is no longer required. If your child does require updated medication, please provide the medication prior to your child's medication expiring, or if it is due to expire during school holidays, please ensure that your child brings new medication upon their first day back at school. Thank you for your assistance with supporting your children's medical needs.



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Sacraments Update

Due to the Covid-19 situation, we have had to make adjustments to our Sacramental Program for 2020. There may still be some adjustments as to how the sacrament is run and how many services we will need to have. This will depend on the Government regulations in regards to the amount of people who are allowed to gather as a community. We will know more as the weeks continue to unfold and in consultation with Father Andrew this is what has been decided at this stage..

- **Reconciliation:** As our Year 3 students had already prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation prior to remote learning, we anticipate our candidates receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time on:

- **3W:** Tuesday 21st July, 7pm in the church - Week 2 Term 3
- **3SS:** Thursday 23rd July, 7pm in the church - Week 2 Term 3

As we are still unsure of the numbers allowed in the church, we may need to limit the number of people each family can bring to the celebration – we will confirm in Week 1 of Term 3.



- **Confirmation:** This year Father Andrew will Confirm our Year 6 Candidates on **Thursday 15th October** - Week 2, Term 4. At this stage there will be two Confirmation Masses – 5:00pm and 7:00pm. If restrictions still apply, we may need to:

- limit the number of people each family can invite to the celebration, and/or
- conduct another two Confirmation Masses on **Wednesday 14th October**.

More information will follow next term in regards to the Parent/ Child Workshop Evening, Commitment/Medal Masses and the Confirmation Reflection Day.



- **First Eucharist:** Unfortunately, our Year 4 students will not have the opportunity to celebrate their First Eucharist this year. We look forward to celebrating this in Term 1 2021, when they are in Year 5. In 2021, our Year 4s will also celebrate their First Eucharist, more than likely in the second half of the year.



We appreciate your understanding in regards to the change of dates for Sacraments this year.

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Chromebooks for the Holidays

It has been decided that all Chromebooks in Years 4-6 will go home over the Term 2 holiday period. In light of this, we ask you to remember the agreements that were signed to help protect the devices and the students when online.

The ICT User agreement outlines the school's expectations for students working online and the Chromebook User Agreement explains the expectations for Chromebook use, storage and repair. Please feel free to revise both of these. Some of the key points to note include:

- Chromebooks are school owned devices designed for learning - no unauthorised gaming, social media, no subscriptions, etc. allowed.*
- Keep it off uneven and dangerous surfaces, eg. the floor and beds. Look after the charger and don't let it get stood on.*
- No food or drink around it - any spill could damage the whole device.*
- Any damage will be paid for by students and parents and MUST be fixed at school - no broken or damaged devices are to be fixed through other companies or any parts replaced at home, otherwise the warranty will be void.*

We also wish to remind you of some of the recommendations we made during the remote learning period. These are outlined below:

Online safety:

a. Planning for safety

- Ensure your parents and family members are aware of the school expectations when working online from home.*
- Talk with your parents and develop family expectations for screen time, sharing working spaces, using security controls and boundaries for social media use.*
- Refer to the [Top 5 online safety tips for kids](#) and consider developing a personal safety plan. Discuss and share this with your family.*
- Use only credible sources for content searches online.*

b. What to do if you feel unsafe online

- If you feel unsafe online or an incident occurs, stay calm and don't try to deal with the situation alone.*
- Let your parents/carers, teacher or other adult know as soon as possible. They will be able to assist you to report the incident **following school procedures** or by [making a report to the eSafety Commissioner](#).*

c. Respectful online participation for learning and wellbeing

All video, chat and direct messages are monitored through Hapara. Please remember to act within school expectations. Whatever goes online, stays online. Take pride in yourself as a member of the St Justin's community.

You must not:

- re-post a message that was sent to you privately, without the permission of the sender.*
- take or distribute photos, sound or video recordings of anyone connected to the St Justin's community or other people, including background figures and voices, without their express written permission.*
- upload/post/email images, video or sound, containing members of St Justin's staff and students onto social media platforms (e.g. Snapchat, TikTok, Facebook, YouTube) or any other website or app, without their authorisation and the authorisation of the school principal.*
- make deliberate attempts to disrupt other people's use of ICT.*
- use school devices for anything other than school related tasks. (Apps and games that would not be appropriate at school should not be used on your school device. E.g. Tik Tok should not be used on a school device.) We are able to monitor the use of these devices through the Hapara software connected to all school assigned devices.*
- make a request or respond to a request from teachers, counsellors, administrators and other school staff to be 'friends' on social media.*

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Privacy

Our school [ICT User Agreement](#) requires you to take reasonable steps to protect the personal information that is held from misuse and unauthorised access.

St Justin's stress that you take responsibility for the security of your device (e.g. computer, ipad, phone) and not allow it to be used by an unauthorised party.

We really appreciate your support and assistance during this unique time.





Please note for Drop Off and Pick Up:

- *A staff member will be assigned to each zone – they will be clearly identifiable, wearing a high visibility vest. Two staff members will be on duty inside the school grounds and staff members will be on duty in the classrooms.*
- *Once entering the school grounds, students are to make their way to their classroom using the external doors (Year 1s enter via the corridor from the Undercover Area). After sanitising their hands, students can then unpack their bag and participate in some quiet activities in the classroom whilst waiting for the others to arrive. Formal classes will commence at 9:00am.*
- *Parents are to avoid or minimise time spent in or around the school grounds. Any students being dropped off late, or being picked up early, are asked to please phone the office (9561 7644) for further instructions.*
- *At the end of the day, formal classes will conclude at 3:10pm, at which time students with surname starting with A-D (the 3:15pm pick up), will be called to the Undercover Area and line up according to their Zone (4 in total). The process will be repeated every 5 minutes until all students are dismissed and collected.*
- *When picking up, parents/grandparents/carers are asked to wait in their zone at their assigned time. Staff members will bring students to the assigned zone at the assigned time (it might be worth making sure your child/children can identify your vehicle). If permanent pickup arrangements (involving other families) are in place, please email the office office@sjwheelershill.catholic.edu.au informing us of the arrangements. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, your normal arrangement for pick up changes, please let the office know (9561 7644) in reasonable time so that we can coordinate the end of the day dismissal. Students will not be allowed to travel with another family unless prior confirmation has been made with the office.*

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- Any student not collected by 3:40pm will be taken to the office and parents will be contacted.
- In case of poor weather, all students should carry a jacket and umbrella.
- Please consider our neighbours - do not park across driveways.
- Please ensure you move quickly away from these parking areas at both drop off and pick up to enable parents after you to park safely.

Winter Uniform Orders

Academy Uniforms have advised that their Springvale store is open. They are located at 2/810-818 Princes Highway, Springvale and their operating hours are Tuesdays and Thursdays 09:00am – 5:00pm and Saturday mornings 09:00am – 12:00 noon.

They are currently recommending that you visit sooner rather than later given that students will re-commence returning to school from Tuesday 25th May.

They are fully stocked and adhering to social distancing and disinfecting all surfaces between sales. 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Wellbeing Fun Fact- Did you know you can grow your brain?

Do you remember learning to drive a car? Thinking it was an impossible task – so many things to remember – hands at 10 and 2, indicate, check your mirrors, which is the brake pedal again? You could have taken a fixed mindset approach to this task – “this is too hard”, “I’m never going to get it”, “I give up”. Most of us chose the growth mindset path – we practiced, and practiced, and practiced some more. Now we can drive a car without even thinking about the mechanical actions we are carrying out – we can even sing along to a song on the radio at the same time!!

This is due to the plasticity of the brain, also called neuroplasticity. Neuroplasticity refers to the ability of the brain to change and become stronger the more you use it, like a muscle. The brain is made up of approximately 86 billion neurons – nerve cells within the nervous system that have the ability to transmit information throughout the whole body. It was once thought that the creation of new neurons was completed shortly after birth, however researchers today know that our brains have the capacity to reorganise pathways, create new connections and even

Neurons
When you were born, your brain came with neurons, a type of tiny cell.

Signals



HOW TO EXPLAIN GROWTH MINDSET TO KIDS

NEUROPLASTICITY ACTIVITIES AND RESOURCES

- TALK ABOUT THEIR BRAIN**
 - Provide a basic explanation of the main parts of the brain.
 - Explain neurons and pathways.
 - Use analogies such as establishing new neural pathways between brain cells is like building a bridge to cross a ravine.
 - Discuss the value of making mistakes.
- SHARE AMAZING FACTS**
 - There are as many neurons in the brain as there are stars in the Milky Way: about 100 billion.
 - The brain physically stops growing around age 18, but it keeps changing forever.
 - The brain can produce enough electricity to power a light bulb!
 - By design, our brains are all about growth and change— as is the whole human body.
- BUILD A BRAIN MODEL**
 - Build a basic brain model using Play-Doh.
 - Make a brain hat.
 - Create neurons from modeling clay, beads, rope, or string.
- CREATE A BRAIN POSTER**
 - Make the “I Can Grow My Brain” poster (available in Big Life Journal’s Growth Mindset Printables Kit).
- CELEBRATE MISTAKES**
 - Explain that mistakes make the brain grow.
 - The brain does NOT grow just from getting the answers right. To keep strengthening neural pathways, we must continue challenging ourselves.
 - Celebrate when someone makes a mistake. Give a high five and say, “High five! You’re learning!” or, “Woohoo! Your brain is growing!”
- BRAINSTORM WAYS NEUROPLASTICITY HAS ALREADY WORKED**
 - Help your children or students come up with a list of activities that were once difficult and became much easier with practice.
 - Keep the list somewhere visible.
 - When children feel that something is too hard, remind them of all the things that were once “too hard” and are now second nature.
- READ FANTASTIC ELASTIC BRAIN**
 - Your children will learn about the brain by reading *Your Fantastic Elastic Brain: Stretch It, Shape It* by JoAnn Deak.
 - This book explains that trying new things without giving up strengthens your brain.
- CREATE INTERACTIVE VISUALS**
 - Provide many pieces of cut yarn to represent connections between neurons.
 - Ask children what they can do to get better at something.
 - Each child who gives a suggestion selects a piece of yarn and gives one end to each of the children holding the neurons.
 - After many examples, children can see how thick the collection of yarn is getting.

Kitchen Garden Program

We are in our final week for the Year Two Kitchen Garden program. It really has been a pleasure teaching the students in this year level with their very enthusiastic response to all discussions and activities. It seems our world is in good hands with these curious and capable future guardians of the earth.

Our recipe this week continued on with the potato theme from last week. Baked potatoes with a variety of toppings ensured that everyone was well fed (well the staff were!!) and it was an allergy friendly meal.



In the garden we continued our understandings about how to provide the best environment for plants to thrive. They not only need water, sunlight, and good soil. They also need protection from harsh weather conditions and pests.



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Following on from last week's bug hotel constructions with their recycled plastic bottles, the students made a newspaper pot for a plant that will attract beneficial insects to the garden. We planted sweet alyssum.



The students observed how recycled plastic like drinking bottles or fruit containers can be used to make a greenhouse to encourage plant growth by providing a humid environment. Within these constructions they are also protected from pests.

It is wonderful to hear of the many stories that the students recall about their own home experiences of garden and cooking. Time spent in the garden is time well spent.

After the holidays it will be time for the Year One students to participate in Kitchen Garden program. We hope you are all looking forward to your time in the garden on the first Thursday of Term 3.

I hope you all have a wonderful break these holidays - getting out into the garden is a great way to spend time and energy and learn along the way.




