*Dear Families and Friends,*

*It's nice to start returning to some sort of "normality". Thanks for your cooperation and understanding with our ever-changing landscape. Our guidelines change on a regular basis and whilst it makes it hard to plan for the future, we are committed to providing opportunities for our community to thrive.*

*Please be mindful that there are certain rules, regulations and guidelines that we need to implement and follow. These are directives from the Catholic Education Commission of Victoria (CECV) via the State Government and have had to be implemented by many business and organisations throughout Victoria - failure to follow them can mean huge fines for those involved.*

*As of next Wednesday, all students will return to school at St Justin's. In summary:*

- **Monday 1st November - School Closure Day** - Assessment & Reporting Day for all students - Staff commence entering details for Semester 2 Reports
- **Tuesday 2nd November - Melbourne Cup Public Holiday**
- **Wednesday 3rd November – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November** – All students return to school

*We are very fortunate to have Fr Andrew as a member of our school community. He is always willing to work with us, and the Covid-19 Guidelines, to ensure that we all continue on our faith journey, and that students have the opportunity to participate in special celebrations including First Eucharist, Confirmation and Graduation. New dates have been set for First Eucharist and Confirmation (refer to later in this newsletter) and whilst the current Government Guidelines will mean a restriction in the number of people who can attend, at least our students will receive the sacraments this year.*

### **Face Mask Regulations - Year Prep to Year 6**

*Parents of Year 3 to Year 6 children are advised that the Government COVID Guidelines:*

- **Directs students in Year 3 to Year 6** to wear face masks when indoors on school premises, unless an exemption applies - parents of children with 'lawful exceptions for mask wearing, including those with disability, medical or a mental health condition' are advised to contact Patrick Torpey - [ptorpey@sjwheelershill.catholic.edu.au](mailto:ptorpey@sjwheelershill.catholic.edu.au)
- **Recommends that Prep to Year 2 children** wear face masks when at school and attending an Out of School Hours Care Program.

*We request that all families specifically adhere to the direction for Year 3 to Year 6 children and take on board the recommendation for Year Prep to Year 2 children.*

### **COVID Safety**

*The school continues to follow the advice from CECV to minimise the risks of transmission of the virus, please note below a few significant COVID Safety measures that may provide some clarity for you:*

- We are being provided with air purifiers but have yet to be advised as to when they will arrive.
- Ventilation is a priority for all work spaces.
- All staff onsite are vaccine compliant.
- Physical distancing is encouraged.

### ***St Justin's "Fair on the Hill" Update***

*Under normal circumstances, this week we would all be busy preparing for our annual Fair on the Hill - preparing stalls, setting up marquees, making cakes and purchasing raffle tickets and wristbands. Who would have thought . . . ? Whilst the Fair on the Hill Committee has continued to work through uncertain times, it was decided that this year's Fair on the Hill would not go ahead, but after a two year break, we are looking forward to an amazing celebration on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2022. ### ***First Eucharist & Confirmation***

*With the easing of restrictions for gatherings it has reached a point where we can now welcome people back to the church. Even though we can go ahead and celebrate Confirmation and First Eucharist, there are still many guidelines we have to follow as to how the Sacrament is to be administered.*

*The restrictions in place are compulsory. The Chief Health Officer of Victoria has issued a lawful direction as part of the current State of Emergency. This states that indoor Church Celebrations are allowed with a ratio of one person per 4 square metre, who are double vaccinated. This means that our St. Justin's Church can have a maximum of 75 people.*

*This means students involved in the sacraments will be able to invite two other people who are double vaccinated. For Confirmation, this means each candidate will be able to invite their sponsor and only 1 other person under the current restrictions. We understand that this will be very difficult for all families, and we acknowledge that it has been a year filled with many challenges. However if regulations change prior to the scheduled dates, we will happily notify you with the increase in numbers.*

*The new dates are as follows:*

#### ***Confirmation: Thursday 25th November***

- *Year 6DW - 5:00pm Mass*
- *Year 6S - 7:00pm Mass*

#### ***Year 5 First Eucharist: Saturday 4th December***

- *Year 5SS - 2:00pm Mass*
- *Year 5CI - 4:00pm Mass*

#### ***Year 4 First Eucharist: Sunday 5th December***

- *Year 4L - 2:00pm Mass*
- *Year 4G - 4:00pm Mass*

### ***Kitchen Garden***

*The year ones have resumed their kitchen garden program onsite and by all accounts they very much enjoyed using the new digging tools to unearth the soil in the garden beds, and identify all the vegetables that have really taken off whilst they have been at home.*

*This week in the kitchen the students made a Weetbix slice (recipe below) with a focus on investigating the capacity of containers and units of measurement when following recipes. In the garden the focus was on compost, and how our food scraps contribute towards refuelling the garden making it better not just for the soil, but our environment by preventing the food from going into landfill. Some of the compost was dug into the garden bed in preparation for planting in the coming weeks.*



### ***National Recycling Week***

*From Monday 8th November to Sunday 14th November we celebrate this important event on the Sustainability calendar. Recycling is not just about paper or food scraps. It can also be about considering how to reuse a product to avoid it going into landfill. At St Justin's we have registered our school to celebrate National Recycling Week by participating in activities from the Cool Australia website that teaches students about recycling. We have an opportunity to win a \$1,100 buddy bench made from recycled plastics. We are also being creative by reusing the plastic bottle tops that we have been collecting all year to create art work for our school. This is an ongoing project and we look forward to sharing pictures soon.*

### *Baked Weetbix Slice*

#### *Ingredients*

- *4 Weet-Bix crushed*
- *1 cup plain flour*
- *1/2 cup coconut*
- *1/2 cup sugar*
- *1 tbs cocoa*
- *70 g butter*
- *1/4 cup water*

#### *Icing*

- *Icing sugar*
- *milk*



#### *Method*


- 1. Preheat oven to 180C (160C fan-forced). Melt butter and mix into crushed Weet-Bix.*
- 2. Add remaining ingredients and stir to combine.*
- 3. Line a square cake tin with baking paper. Press the Weet-Bix mixture into the base. Bake for 15 minutes.*
- 4. To make icing, sift icing sugar into a bowl. Add milk gradually, stirring, until you have a smooth, spreadable consistency. Pour icing over the slice in the tin. Spread to cover completely. Allow to set. Slice.*

### *Wheelers Hill Library Letter to the Community*

*Hello,*

*The Wheelers Hill Library (and other Monash Public Library branches) will be reopening to the public on Wednesday 3 November from 10am. Our hours will be 10am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 9am to 4pm on Saturdays.*

*It is important to note that as per the Government requirements, students **under 16 years must be accompanied by a vaccinated adult (regardless of the child's vaccination status)**. Students 16 and over may attend the library alone but are required to prove double vaccination (or hold a valid exception). This may deny access to some of your students who would normally head to the library straight from school. This requirement may change once we reach 90% vaccination.*

*All visitors to the library will be met by a concierge located outside in the library (Ferntree Gully Road entrance) and are required to use the Services Victoria app/QR code and be double vaccinated (or show proof of medical exemption). People not fully vaccinated or without a medical exception will not be able to enter the library (Click & Collect services will still be available).*

*Density requirements on the number of simultaneous visitors to the library will be in place when we reopen.*

*Hopefully this information may be able to be communicated to your school community.*


